There are several theories regarding the meaning of "evenk" from the name Evenks. The most well-known theory suggests that it means "people living in the vast forest" while a different linguistic interpretation argues that it means "person who came down from the forest high in the mountains." "People living in the vast forest" seems to have derived from the life style of hunting and herding reindeer the Evenks have led in the Daxing'anling Mountains. This book covers the origin, history, and customs of the Evenks residing on either bank of the Amur River, including their social organization, dwelling, dietary, and dressing cultures, transition rites, and shamanism. The book therefore shares a glimpse into the society and culture of the Evenks, providing a chance to picture all the forests the ancestors of these mysterious people must have traveled through in the company of reindeer year after year.

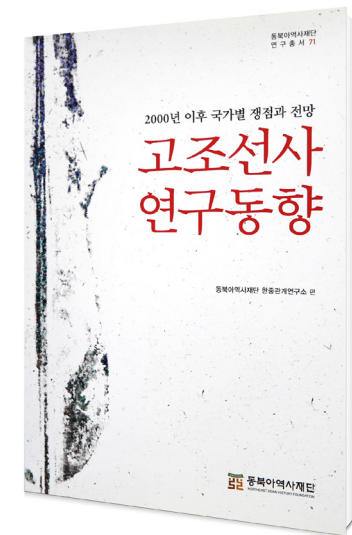


Dokdo is historically, geographically, and legally Korean territory. Nevertheless, ever since Shimane Prefecture proclaimed the establishment of Takeshima Day in 2005, Japan has been explicitly challenging Korea's sovereignty over Dokdo by distorting descriptions about the island in its defense white paper, diplomatic bluebook, and history textbooks. This book draws from various disciplines including history, geography, international law and politics to academically review how Korea has defended its sovereignty over Dokdo throughout history. The book has been published in the hopes that it may help Korea and Japan in overcoming issues underneath bilateral historical conflicts so that the two countries may truly achieve historical reconciliation and establish the foundation for a peaceful and prosperous Northeast Asian community in the twenty-first century.

Based on such a viewpoint, China is arguing that remains and relics discovered in Liaoxi and Liaodong have nothing to do with Gojoseon, the first kingdom in Korean history. This book reviews research findings on Gojoseon history published in South Korea, North Korea, China, and Japan since 2000 to present the trend and issues related to studies performed in each country. Mention of the Dongyi first appeared in a Bronze Age inscription during the time of Western Zhou. Those people are also referred to as the Eastern Dongyi or pre-Qin Dongyi, considering the time and range of their activity described in inscriptions, rujia texts, or scriptures. The next mention emerged much later when Chinese books included sections titled Dongyi liezhuan, or biographies of the Dongyi. Those people are also referred to as the Northeastern Dongyi considering their range of activities throughout the three northeastern provinces of China, the Korean peninsula, and the Japanese archipelago. This book focuses on the Dongyi of Shandong, China, representing the first step to exploring the Northeastern Dongyi related to ancient Korean kingdoms. The contributing authors are archaeologists, historians, and experts in studying epigraphs or oracle bone script. Rather than taking the dichotomous approach of associating the Dongyi with a particular ethnicity, the authors highlight the importance of considering and understanding the dynamic and diverse nature of the people.

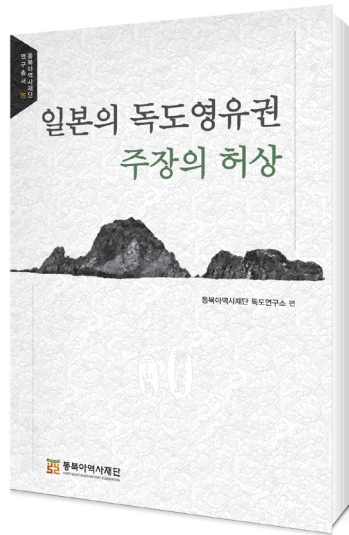


The fact that Gojoseon had its own language means there were people who used it and formed a culture based on it within the boundaries of a kingdom. Comparing the languages of Gojoseon and Korea has revealed that the two share a fifty-four percent similarity in terms of vocabulary. This not only supports the theory that Koreans are descendants of the kingdom of Gojoseon, but also adds validity to the controversial argument that Korean is an Altaic language. This book delivers the progress made so far in studying the Gojoseon language, examines the language's use in historical studies, and considers Chinese studies on the Gojoseon language in Fangyan. It also covers comparisons between the languages of Gojoseon, Mongols, Manchu, and Tungus aimed at determining Gojoseon's relations with other ethnicities nearby as well as studies on the linguistic filiation of the Korean language.

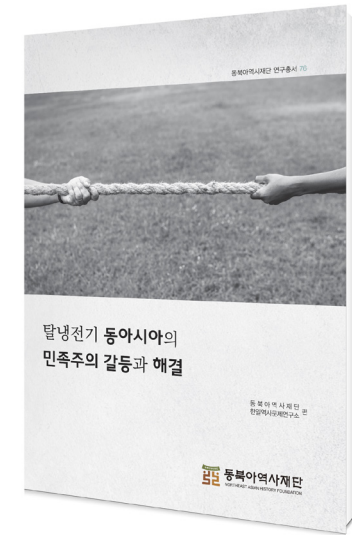


Dokdo was the first in Korea to fall victim to Japanese colonial imperialism and therefore symbolizes Korea's complete recovery of its territorial sovereignty. The sovereignty claims Japan has been making over the island are a grave violation of Korea's sovereignty over what has historically, geographically, and legally been part of Korean territory. Moreover, such claims are based on Japan's denial of the truth about its illegal occupation and invasion of Korea including Dokdo, not to mention a negation of international legal justice. The graveness of this matter ultimately lies in the fact that distorted education about Dokdo is now being forced upon the next generation of Japan. This book aims to provide broad, in-depth interdisciplinary studies involving history, geography, international law and politics to expose the illusory aspects of Japan's sovereignty claim over Dokdo.

Against such circumstances, the conflicts China ran into in the 2000s with its neighbors including Korea and Japan over issues involving territory and historical perceptions stimulated nationalist sentiments among the Chinese. Advances in science and technology brought increased access to the Internet and allowed such Chinese sentiments to spread online, which aggravated nationalist conflicts between the three Northeast Asian countries. This book reviews such nationalist conflicts and explores ways to resolve them.

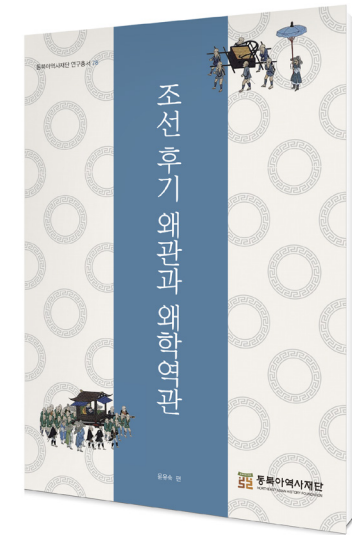

Regardless of time and place, interpreters well-versed in the language and culture of the other country are indispensable to diplomatic occasions between countries with different languages and cultures. This also proved to be true in the relations between late Joseon and Japan. The two countries each systematically trained interpreters to serve diplomatic purposes, which entailed facilitating communication and taking the lead in carrying out procedural rituals for everyday trade and diplomatic activities that took place at Waegwans, or Japanese trade posts in Joseon. Interpreters also accompanied and assisted envoys who led Tongsin missions from Joseon to Japan. In essence, interpreters had to be aware of the ins and outs of Joseon's policy that sought to maintain friendly relations with its neighbor Japan. This book focuses on such interpreters of late Joseon who directly served their dynasty's diplomatic exchanges with Japan, featuring the diverse roles they actually played as government officials, scribes, compilers, merchants, and diplomats. By doing so, this book hopes to offer glimpses into the ins and outs of late Joseon's relations with Japan.

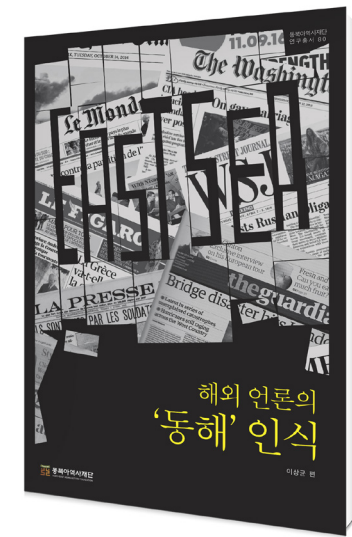

The nineteenth century was a time when meetings and exchanges between East and West surged in frequency and maps were made through scientific explorations. Around that time, Japan jumped into producing maps of the world by enthusiastically accepting Western map-making traditions and offering its geographic information to the West. To draw closer to the truth behind the claims of sovereignty Japan is now making over Dokdo, this book turns to diverse perspectives to analyze in detail how Westerners and the Japanese recognized Ulleungdo and Dokdo in early modern times.

Since the two Koreas simultaneously joined the United Nations in 1991, the South Korean government has made various efforts to spread the idea of concurrently using the name East Sea as opposed to the sole use of the name Sea of Japan. As a result, many countries around the world have come to understand the South Korean argument and map makers have started to use both names. This process made more apparent the importance of the media in promoting the name East Sea. Newspapers and news broadcasts have continued to be a reliable channel for foreigners to gain information about developments in Korea. Reviewing how Korea has been covered through leading media outlets around the world would therefore be useful to further promoting the name East Sea in the future. This book reviews relevant studies conducted thus far and traces which names are being used for the East Sea in different language groups and how they were introduced and spread. Also, by attempting to determine what the preference is for naming the East Sea, the book provides implications and suggestions worth being considered by the South Korean government and related institutions as they try to decide what aspects to focus on as they draft policies to promote the name East Sea.

This book reviews naval policies of imperialist powers and change in the modern East Asian order based on the aspects of interactions and interlinks. Since the Industrial Revolution, the sea was no longer a barrier interrupting exchange, but a route bringing the world together as one. This rapid modernization around East Asian waters intensified competition between imperialist powers seeking to boost trade and secure a strategic base in East Asia. This book examines the contest between imperialist powers for hegemony in East Asian waters at the turn of the century. By focusing on maritime connections in East Asian and world history, this book is aimed at contributing to understanding East Asian history within the context of world history.

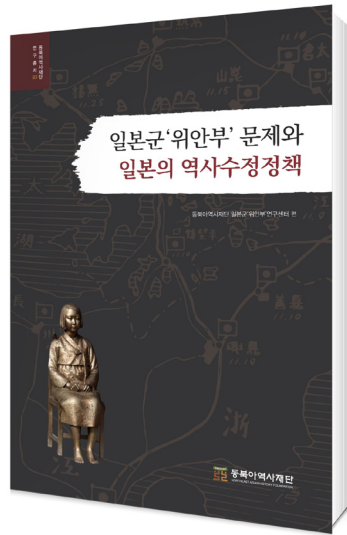

Over the past few years, Chinese research on Korean history began to move away from the type of research methods adopted through the Northeast Project. Instead, attempts are being made to fortify originally flimsy arguments for attribution while broadening the search for issues involving histories that have not yet been subjected to distortion. NAHF detected the intention of Chinese academia to reassign Baekje, a major component of ancient Korean history, as part of Chinese history. Recognizing the possibility for similar studies to emerge, NAHF has been trying to identify the trend of Chinese research on Baekje history and collaborate with Korean experts on Baekje to devise academic responses. This book reflects such efforts by pointing out the issues and limitations to Chinese research on Baekje history that makes indiscriminate use of accounts about Baekje in Chinese historical records.

The "Comfort Women" Issue and the Japanese Policy of Historical Revisionism

This book is the first publication to academically review the Japanese military "comfort women" issue as a matter of historical justice. With the title serving as the book's overarching theme, the first part of the book covers Japanese government policies on operating the comfort women system and the essence of the comfort women issue. The book's second part presents discussions about the Japanese government's practice of historical revisionism and the international society's reactions. To urge the Japanese government to stop avoiding its responsibility toward comfort women victims, this book suggests that it step away from its policy of historical revisionism based on the legitimacy of colonial rule and the finality of the 1965 Korea-Japan Treaty. The book thereby aims to contribute to forming a basis for the Japanese government to acknowledge the need to pursue true historical justice and seek resolutions to the comfort women issue from a victim-centered approach established by the international society to evolve into a community respectful of human rights, justice, and peace.

Nippon Kaigi and the Rightist Abe Administration

Nippon Kaigi, or the Japan Conference, is the political bedrock of the Abe administration so that most of the administration's major policies, including that regarding constitutional revision, are aligned with the goals of Nippon Kaigi.

Since the Abe administration seems likely to remain in power for the time being, research on a domestically influential organization such as Nippon Kaigi would prove useful in studying the conservative shift in Japan and anticipating the future direction of Japanese policies. This book delves into the substance of Nippon Kaigi by examining its official documents, published material about the organization, and books or academic papers authored by major commentators who are Nippon Kaigi members. To help readers better understand the substance of Nippon Kaigi, the book particularly focuses on how Nippon Kaigi uses Prime Minister Abe as well as other politicians in the Liberal Democratic Party to instill its arguments into government policies regarding constitutional revision, national security, and history education.

As news of the National Qing History Project (Qingshi gongcheng) in China reached Korea in 2006, Korean scholars specializing in the Ming, Qing, and modern periods of Chinese history or the Joseon and modern periods of Korean history began to voice the need to conduct more objective studies on Korea-China relations. It was an effort to overcome the conflicts and disputes bound to occur from self-centered historical descriptions. Hence, reexamining Korea-China relations to establish a more objective perception of history should help steer such bilateral relations toward a positive direction and contribute to an East Asian future of peaceful coexistence.

This book presents a general history of Joseon's relations with Ming and Qing China between the fifteenth and nineteenth century, thereby suggesting a research framework for studying Korea-China relations. With each chapter dedicated to a specific century, experts on Korean or Chinese historical perspectives particularly cover details about bilateral relations throughout the sixteenth and seventeenth century when Korea suffered a series of invasions from the Japanese and the Manchus.

The Official Histories of China (Zhengshi) are classics when it comes to studying Sinology including Chinese history, ideas, and literature. In addition, the society, culture, politics, and foreign relations of nearby ethnic groups can be glimpsed from the Profiles of Foreign Nations (Waiguichuan) included in the Collection of Biographies (Liezhuan). The Records of East Barbarians (Dongyichuan) especially serves as a vital source for researching Korean history when there are so few historical sources available for study that date back to periods prior to the Goryeo dynasty. Although Dongyichuan is a primary source informing how the ancient Chinese perception of Korea changed over time, excerpts from it have been indiscriminately used in the studies on ancient Korean history without considering their provenance. NAHF has therefore published a collated edition of the biographies of all eastern barbarians that appear in Chinese historical records ranging from Shiji to Xin Wudaishi. By collating the Nanjian edition with the Wuyingdian edition, this book is expected to serve as a basic source for research into ancient Korean history.

The Sakuma Jinpachi Report contains the results of an investigation Sakuma Jinpachi conducted on circumstances in Tsushima and its trade with Joseon. Correspondence on Takeshima consists of letters the Tsushima samurai Suyama Shoemon exchanged with his colleague Kashima Hyosuke during the Edo period. The correspondence includes Suyama's opinion on the seventeenth century dispute Japan had with Joseon over the island Ulleungdo. The two historical sources introduced in this book indicate how Tsushima officials tried to preserve their status and interests by failing to faithfully report to the bakufu about the domain's trade with Joseon at a time when Tsushima had been solely placed in charge of handling Japanese trade with Joseon. This book will prove to be an interesting read into how those engaging in trade reacted to the Tsushima government's inconsistent diplomatic measures, how the domain tried to deceive the bakufu, and how the central government managed to see through the domain's deceptions.

Shortly after its establishment, NAHF began collecting materials that may be helpful to uncovering facts about the Japanese military comfort women including official documents of the Japanese government, reports by the Allied Forces, and local sources from China, Taiwan, and Thailand. This collection also includes materials collected by the Korean Ministry of Gender Equality and Family, the National Institute of Korean History, and the research team at Seoul National University's Human Rights Center led by Professor Chung Chin-sung. The collection consists of four volumes: two on Japanese sources, one on reports by the Allied Forces, and one on Chinese, Taiwanese, and Thai sources.

This collection's publication is meaningful in establishing the involvement of the Japanese military and colonial officials in installing comfort stations, mobilizing comfort women, and concealing their involvement, which consequently proves the harm done to comfort women victims. The collection is meant to help navigate sources related to comfort women so that truths about the issue may come to light and contribute to searching for resolutions to the issue.

The first two volumes of Sources on the Japanese Military "Comfort Women" devotes a total of 3,521 pages to a collection of 594 annotated sources disclosed by the Japanese government as well as other sources scholars and civic groups uncovered since the Kono Statement's release. Despite other sources such as victim testimonies, videos, photographs, journals, and newspaper articles, this collection was limited to official documents the Japanese government released over two installments. The sources have been arranged by the institution where they are held, and the classification numbers originally assigned by the Japanese government have been preserved to assist scholars when they personally consult any of the documents. The sources collected by scholars and civic groups after the Kono Statement's release have been grouped according to the place where they were discovered and arranged in chronological order within each group. Some material may not explicitly contain content about comfort stations or women but have been included for their relevance to understanding the comfort women issue. This volume is significant for offering the chance to discover what sort of information the Allied Forces acquired and gauge how they perceived the comfort women issue. It should be an effective guide for researchers who wish to gain access in the future to materials issued by the Allied Forces.

Sources in Taiwan areas are mainly useful to understanding the installation of comfort stations and mobilization of comfort women in the Guangdong area of China in which the Taiwan Government-General or the Taiwan Development Company was involved.

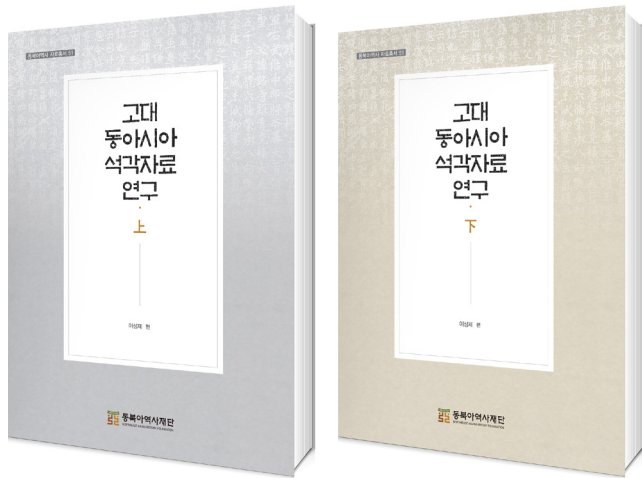
Sources in Thailand areas introduced through this volume amount to sixty which NAHF collected from the National Archives of Thailand in August 2011. Many of them are related to repatriation matters and others provide lists of personnel or are related to the installation and management of comfort stations.

Documents presented in this fourth volume prove that Korean and Chinese women were abducted and mobilized as comfort women in system primarily operated by the Japanese government and military.

Discovering and utilizing new material has always been key to research in an academic field like ancient East Asian history that struggles with a limited number of sources to study. In this respect, stone engravings such as epitaphs or inscriptions on monuments of triumph, tombs, caves, or towers have been gaining attention as sources capable of overcoming the limitations presented by written records and contributing to the restoration of new historical images. Despite such expectations, stone engravings are still being used as supplementary sources in limited capacities either because some lack punctuation marks that make it difficult to decipher them or because their authenticity remains under question.

This book reviews the filiation of these tricky stone engravings related to ancient East Asian history and offers interpretations and annotations of those that carry historical significance. Scholars who participated in the project for this book came to recognize the potential of stone engravings as sources for historical research and collaborated to secure new sources for studying ancient to medieval Chinese history and ancient Korean history.

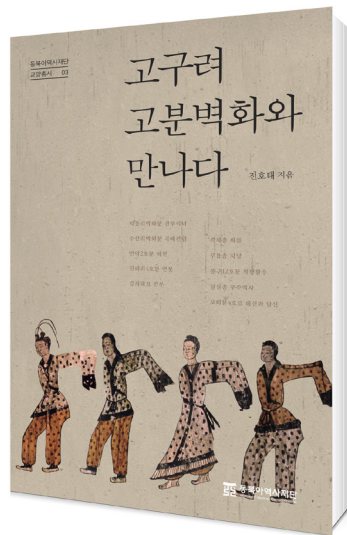

It also developed out of questions on whether opportunities can be created for Koreans in Yanbian and the Tumen River estuary to make a leap forward as such areas evolve into spaces of transborder cooperation. To South Korea, the Yanbian area where the borders of North Korea, China, and Russia meet may appear to be a gateway to mainland China, but to China or Russia, the same area may be considered a bridgehead for advancing into the Korean peninsula. 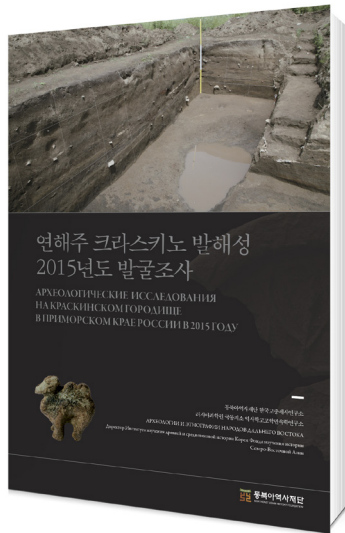

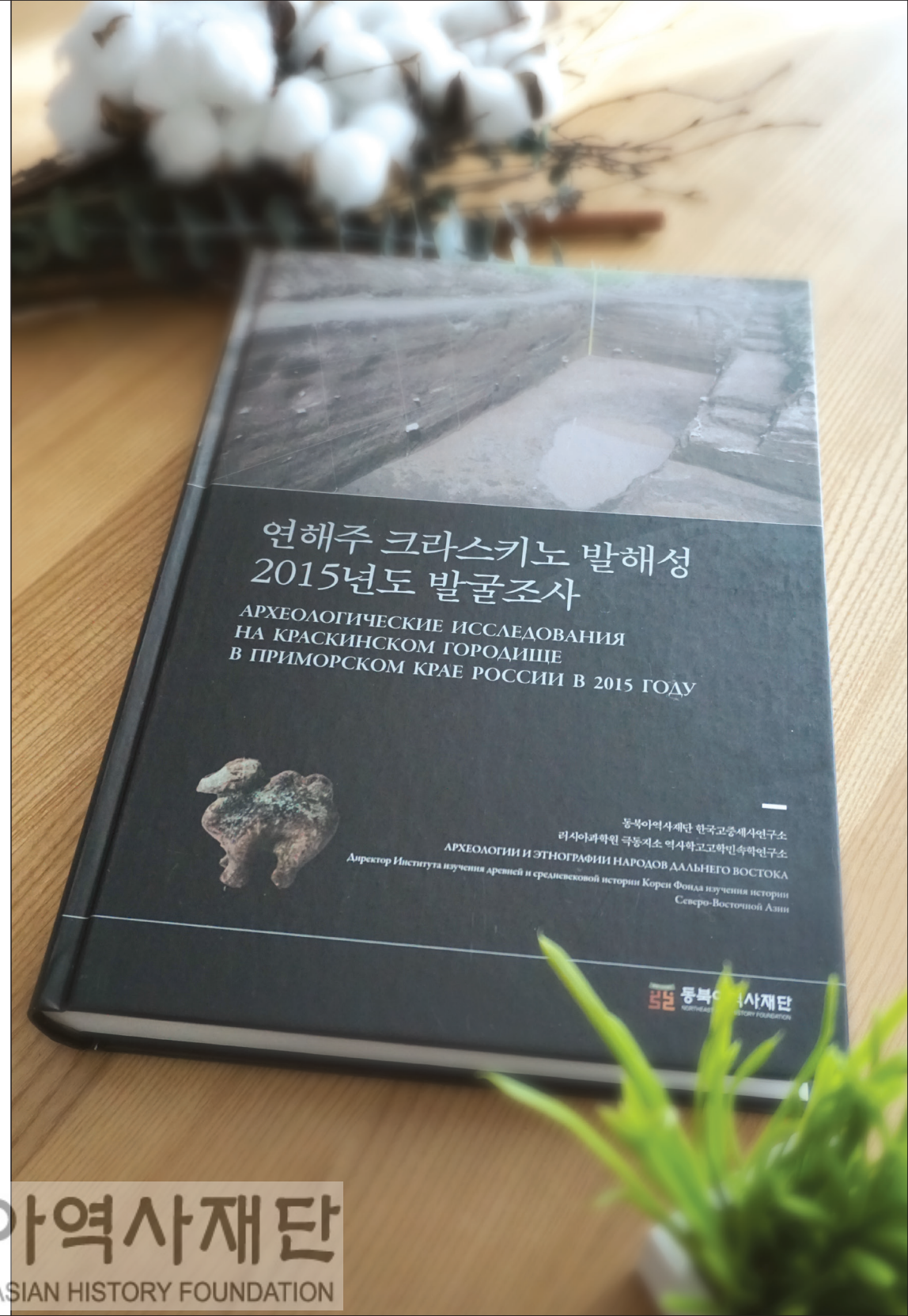

By the NAHF Institute on Pre-modern Korean History and the Institute of History, Archaeology and Ethnography of the Peoples of the Far East under the Far Eastern Branch of the Russian Academy of Sciences Primorsky Krai in Russia is an area closely related to Korean history. It was through this area that Goguryeo and its successor Balhae actively engaged in exchange with other East Asian countries. And the area still serves as a bridge between Korea and Russia. For one, the joint excavation of a Balhae castle site in Kraskino serves as evidence of active academic exchange taking place between the two countries in Primorsky Krai. The 2015 report includes the results after analyzing charcoal samples from the site, proving that the castle's walls date back to the days of Goguryeo. 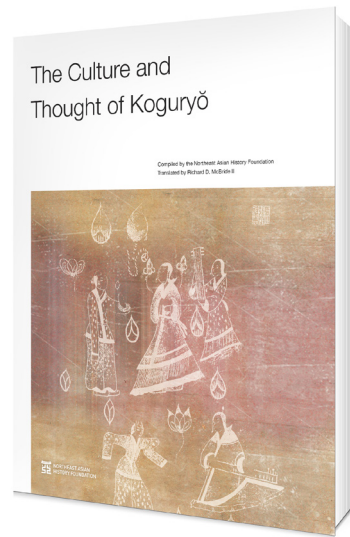

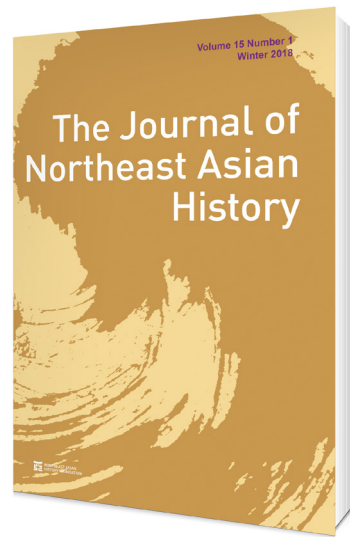

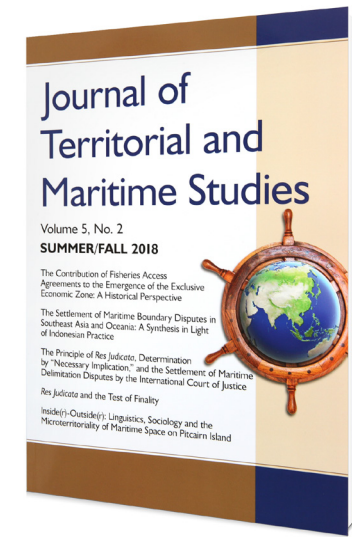
