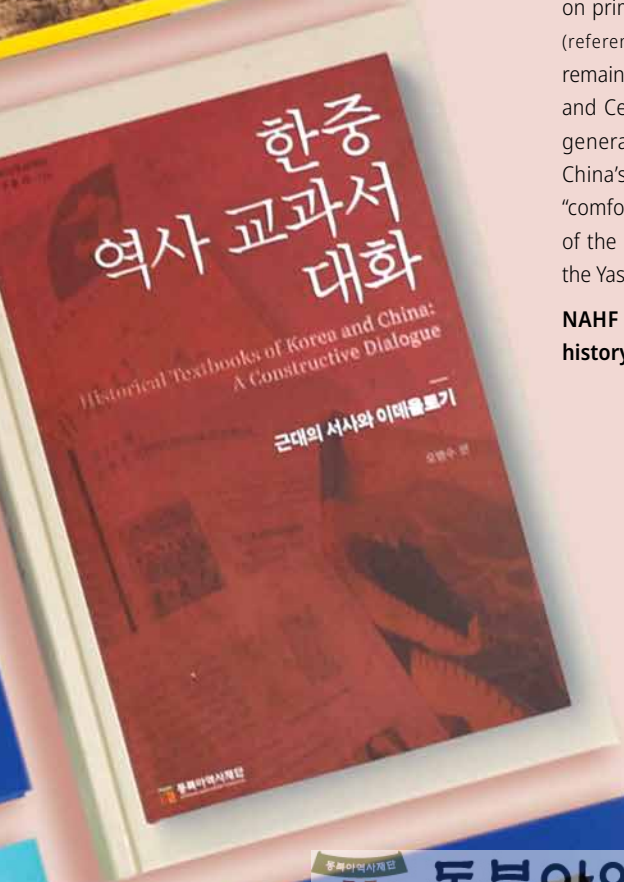

This book analyzes the Japanese study of legal grounds in international law for claiming its territorial sovereignty over Dokdo, and shows that the Japanese legal study that have informed its political policy of the Dokdo issue is biased to the colonialism of the past and flawed in legal logics and spirits of international law.

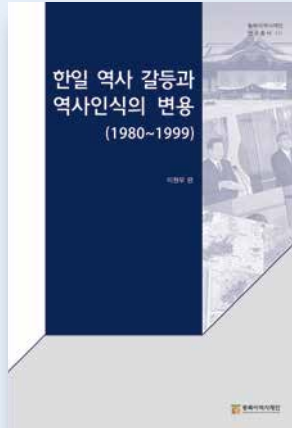


## Milestones of Historical Reconciliation II

Among the polities treated in this book, one group of polities such as Buyeo, Koguryo, Okjeo, and Balhae have been incorporated into the current domain of Korean history, while the other group of polities such as Eupru, Seonbi, Dolgwol, Mulgil, Malgal, the Khitans, and the Jurchens, which had maintained interactions and exchange with Korea's ancient and medieval kingdoms, have been considered outside the domain of Korean history.

This book examines the research institutes on Manchuria run by individual imperial powers to help achieve imperialist goals associated with it. In particular, the book aims to illustrate the modern academic methodologies in East Asia utilized from the Chinese perceptions of Manchuria. It is hoped that the book represents an initiative to understand these historical issues in new perspectives and to search for desirable alternatives for their resolution.



## China's Patriotism and Construction of Its Ancient History

Its ancient history as constructed by China offers a window to sense what China envisions as its future. By extension, it is implied that in the future China will be entitled to lead the world civilization. Korea has maintained historically close relationship with China even until today. Since the choices made by China must be closely associated with the future course of Korea, Koreans cannot dispense with keen interest in China's construction of its ancient history.

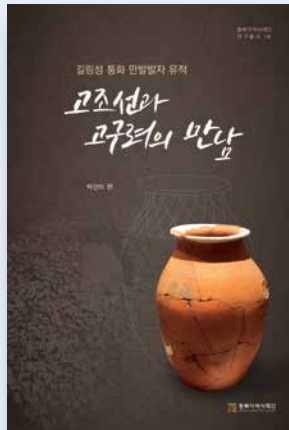


## The Great Jin Dynasty, A Golden Empire of Warriors

### Study on the Jin's Government Strategies

The Great Jin Dynasty founded by Wanyan Aguda in 1115 was an empire built through sacrifice of warriors' blood and sweat. Within only 12 years after its inception, the Jin conquered the Khitan Liao and the Northern Song, and emerged as a hegemon of the East Asian region. The Jin marked progress in many fields from its predecessor, the Khitan Liao, such as establishing bureaucracy to operate the empire, securing military and economic power, introducing a religious system, and obtaining political legitimacy. On the other hand, the dynasty did not show tolerance to the Han Chinese culture, and was willing to use violence in imposing the Jurchen customs on the Han Chinese people, who had remained discriminated throughout the Jin rule. Those are some of the examples of dark aspect of its rule.



## Connection between Gojoseon and Koguryo

This book focuses on the Wanfabozi archaeological site in Tonghua of Jilin Province—the earliest discovered remains of Gojoseon and Koguryo chronically arranged in vertical tiers. Scholars have paid keen attention to the site, because the artifacts discovered there have been considered as a key to trace the movements of the people of Gojoseon after its fall as well as the origin of Koguryo stone-filled tombs. Through their careful analysis of the unearthed relics and comparison with the neighboring remains reported previously, seven scholars present a possibility of connection between Gojoseon and Koguryo cultures.

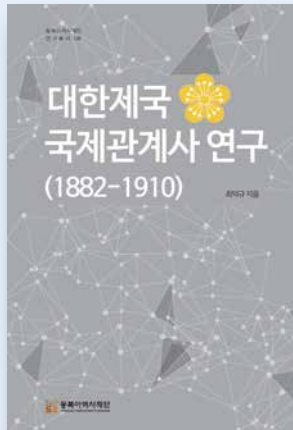

The newly state-authored history textbooks not only have embraced the revisionist historical views of the current Chinese government but also adopted China-centered approach in describing histories of its neighbors, as shown by the Northeast Project. This book brings together select research results that analyze China's revised educational policies and history textbooks for secondary schools since the shift to the state-authored system.

In addition, the reader of this book is expected to find this book helpful to understanding the U.S. and China in the context of their rising conflicts.

Gojong of the Korea Empire era (1897–1907) followed the model of Western powers in his enterprise of state building. With the ascendancy of Western powers, the sources of knowledge shifted from China to the West, and Korean intellectuals sought modern knowledge from Western nations, depending on their relations with them. The history of Korea Empire implies that the division of Korean even after the end of the cold war cannot be inseparable from the Korean peninsula's geopolitical dynamics as experienced in the era of Korea Empire. This is the reason why the history of Korea Empire ought to be presented in light of international relations.



## Pacifism in Modern East Asia

Comprehending such duality of pacifism in modern East Asia will provide an insight to see the future.

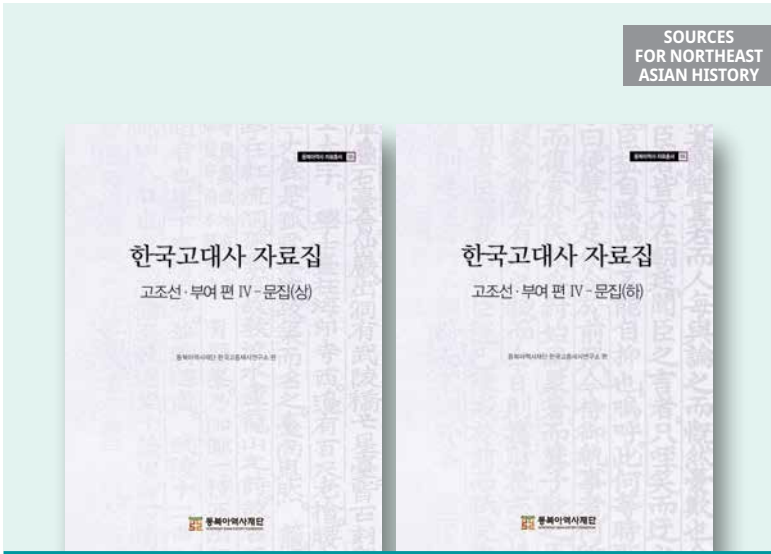

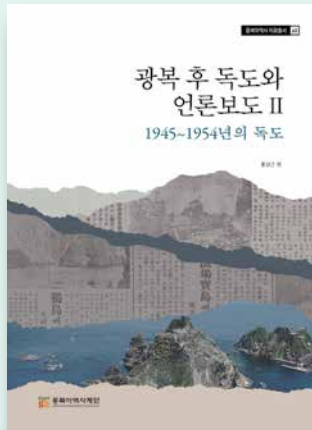

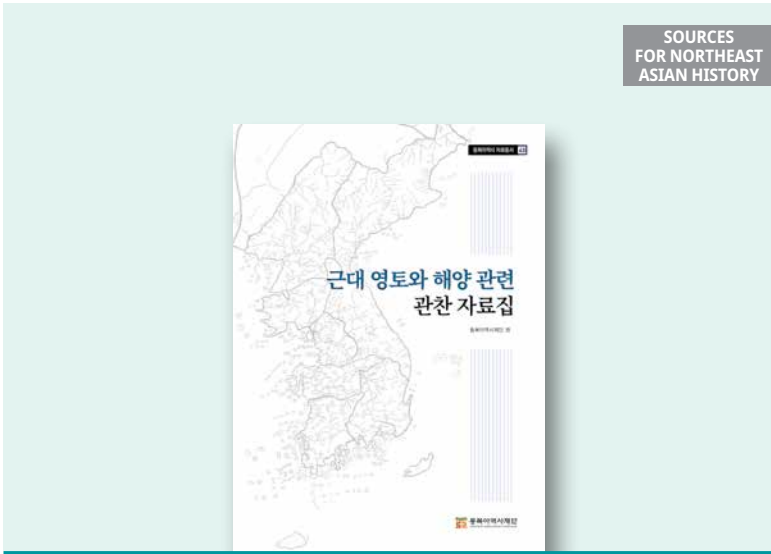

Besides formal historical materials, these sourcebooks collected newspaper editorials, stories, poems, and literary pieces, which tell about the perceptions of contemporary intellectuals about Balhae history. It is expected that the sourcebooks will shed more light on Balhae history and culture, of which little has been known.

A total of 285 frequent keywords have been selected and arranged chronically to refer to the related entries from the official historical sources mentioned above. The sourcebook will serve as the historical basis for claiming Korea's legitimate sovereignty over its land and maritime territories in terms of international law.

The “explanatory materials” about the territorial issues, published by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs between 1946 and 1950 tell about Japan’s territorial policies and perceptions, the key points and the methods to deliver them to the Allied Powers.

## A History of Koguryo

Over the past decade, research on Koguryo history has seen the most substantial change among historical research into ancient Korean kingdoms. New directions and methodologies have been explored using the early articles in the Koguryo Annals of *Samguk sagi*, or the History of the Three Kingdoms. Research topics have grown more specific and diverse, especially in studying the history of Koguryo's politics and external relations. Archaeological studies have gone beyond attempts to offer general observations on North Korean research findings and have been introducing archaeological sources in China. Increased investigations into Koguryo remains in areas south of the Imjin River have led to the production of original research findings. The purpose of *A History of Koguryo* is to faithfully present to academia and the general public the research findings on Koguryo history. The book is therefore expected to serve as a guide to incipient scholars, and for history enthusiasts, as a resource to help them encounter new aspects of Koguryo.

No issue has been more sensitive and controversial in Korea-Japan relations than the Korea-Japan talks for negotiating the 1965 Korea-Japan Treaty. 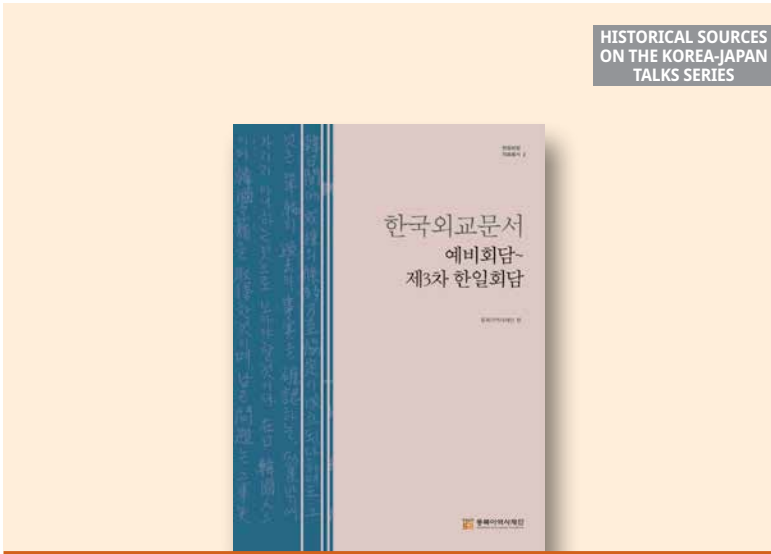

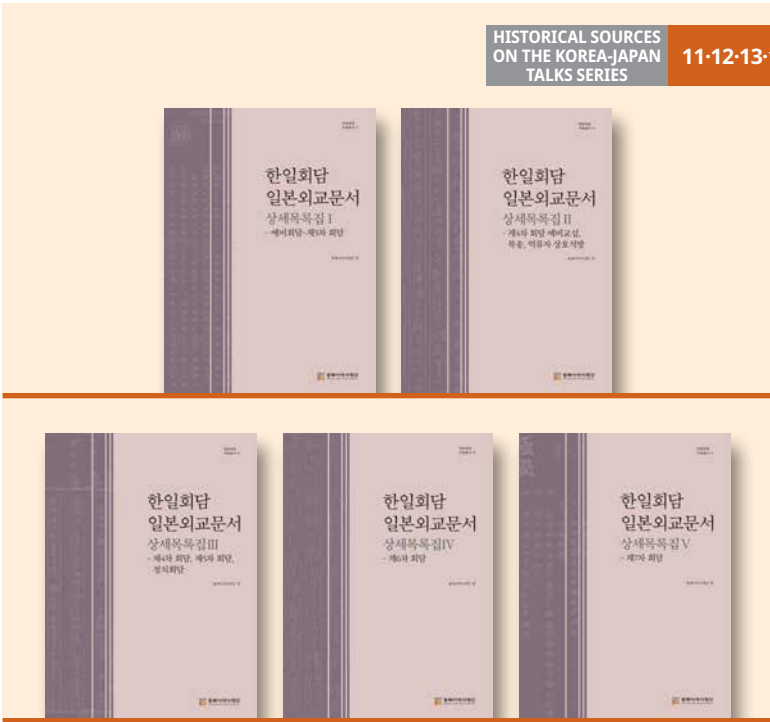
