

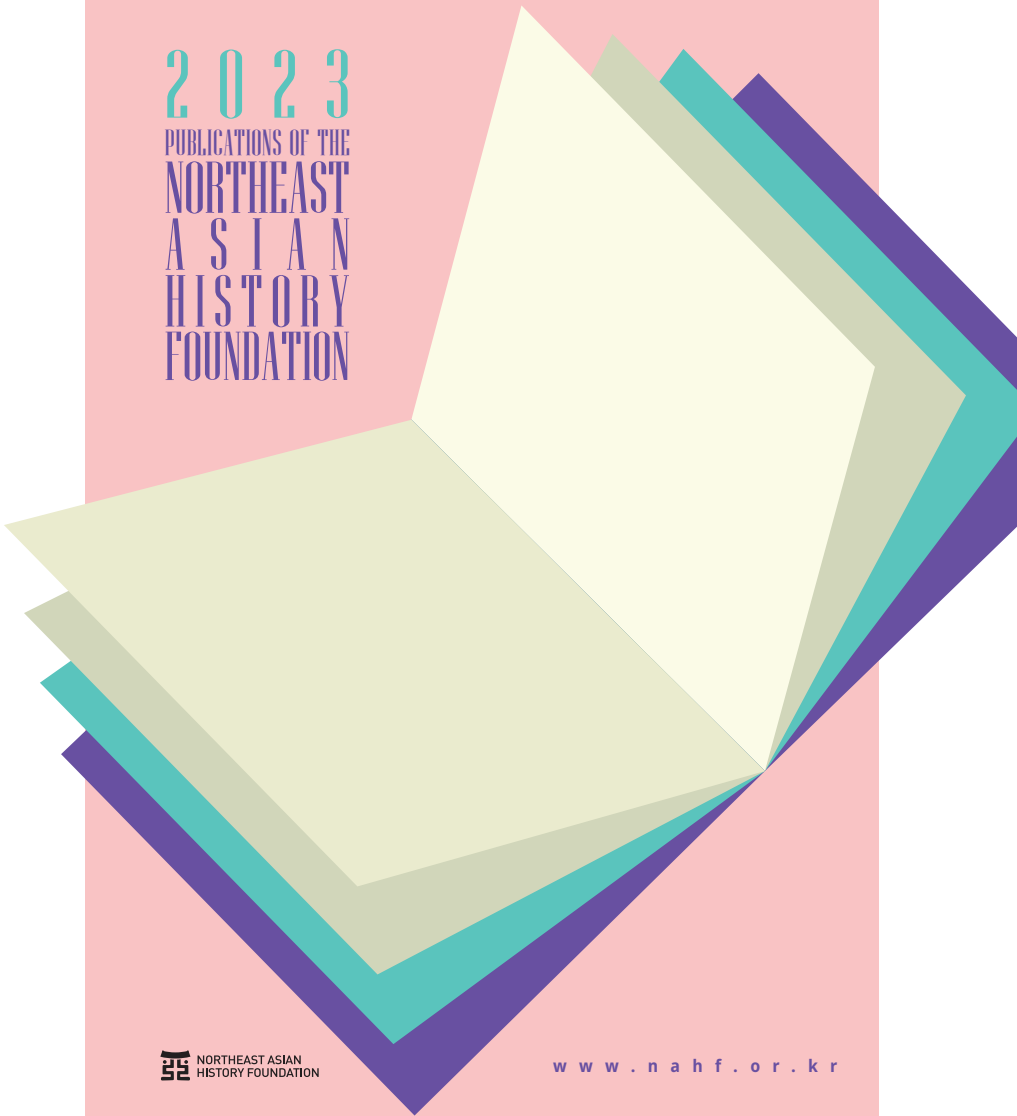

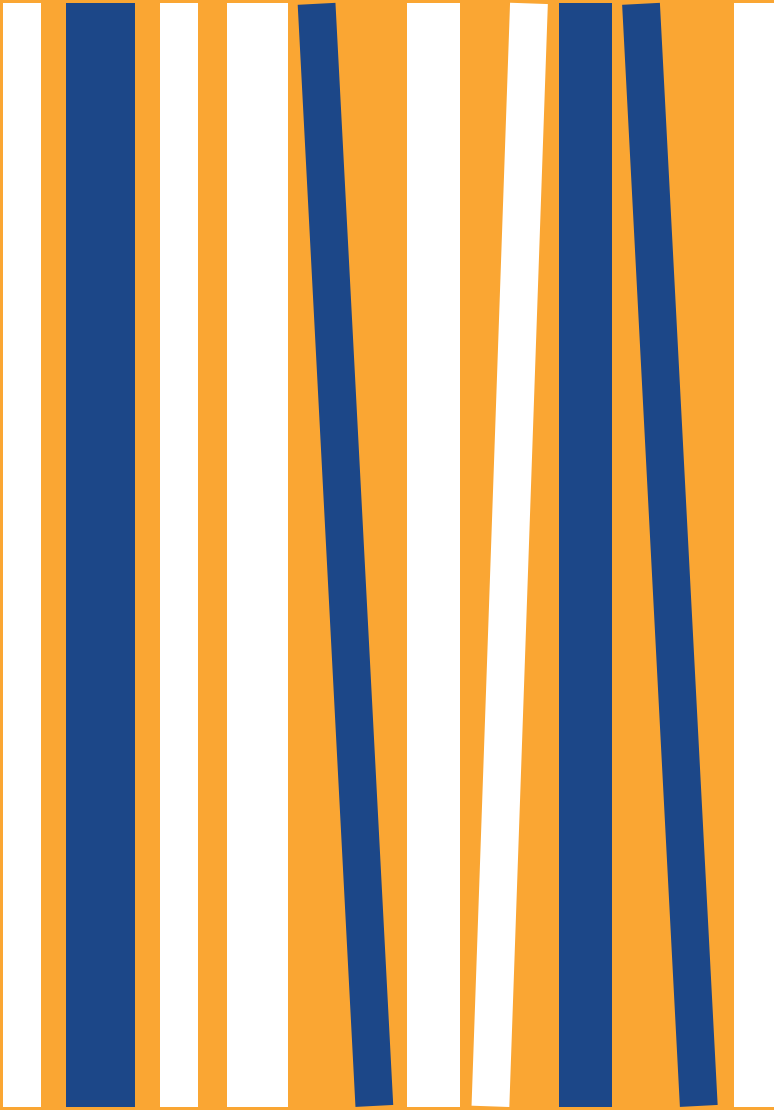

On the occasion of the one hundredth anniversary of the founding of Chinese Communist Party, this book explores changing perceptions toward Korea of the top Chinese leaders in their respective ruling period based on their thoughts and ideologies, and examines, from Korean perspectives, the impacts of China's drive for a powerful nation in the Xi Jinping era based on its thoughts and ideologies on the relations between Korea and China. In addition, the book also offers some comparable points to the Korean Peninsula by investigating the perceptions and perspectives of Vietnam and Taiwan, located similarly to the Korean Peninsula in terms of geopolitics and geoeconomics.



## Territorial Sovereignty over Dokdo and Titles in International Law III

Dokdo is a symbol of Korea's territorial sovereignty and an integral part of Korean territory by history, geography and international law. However, Japan has claimed that Dokdo has been in legitimate possession of Japan in terms of international law ever since 1905, and thus illegally occupied by the Korean government. This book analyzes the Japanese study of legal grounds in international law for claiming its territorial sovereignty over Dokdo, and shows that the Japanese legal studies that have informed its political policy of the Dokdo issue is biased to its colonialism of the past and flawed in legal logics and spirits of international law.



## Milestones of Historical Reconciliation III

Focused on Historical Context and Modernity

This book approaches the question of reconciliation by focusing on its historical context and modernity. The case studies in this volume include British methods of controlling the “factions” in the modern era; rare events of cooperation between Russia and Turkey in their history of contest for power; territorial disputes among Chile, Peru, and Bolivia; the coming of Catholicism in late Joseon Korea under King Jeongjo and social and political reactions to it; the incident of Maria Luz in Meiji Japan; the modern use of the *Dayi juemi lu* 大義覺迷錄, a Qing formular for assimilating the Han people; the “pathos” of Okinawa. In addition, the book also makes a critical analysis on Japan’s territorial claim to Dokdo.



## Current Historical Issues between Korea and Japan (2000–2022)

With the growing importance of global issues, the East Asian specific issues like the historical debates between Korea and Japan, though still ongoing and relevant, have received relatively less attention since the turn of the twentieth century. This book analyzes the variable historical debates and conflicts depending on changing relations between the two countries from multiple perspectives. The author argues that the ultimate goal of studying the historical issues between Korea and Japan is to avoid repeating the past history of invasion and subjection and to realize a value of mutual moderation in working out solutions for historical reconciliation between the two neighbors.



## Cultural Conflicts between Korea and China in Global Age of Culture

Edited by Kim In-hee | 300 pages | 18,000 KRW | 2022 | ISBN 978-89-6187-907-1

This book examines the reasons behind recent cultural disputes between Korea and China over the origins of intangible cultural traditions, such as *Dano* (Korean festival at the beginning of summer) and *Chuseok* (Korean thanksgiving festival), and seeks for ways for reconciling such disputes. This book assumes that cultural disputes and conflicts are not limited to the East Asian region, but a global phenomenon. The book points to China's problematic argument for Chinese origins of certain Korean cultural traditions, based on its defensive, state-initiated, mass-oriented nationalism. It is hoped that the book serves as a sensible Korean response to the cultural challenge posed by China.

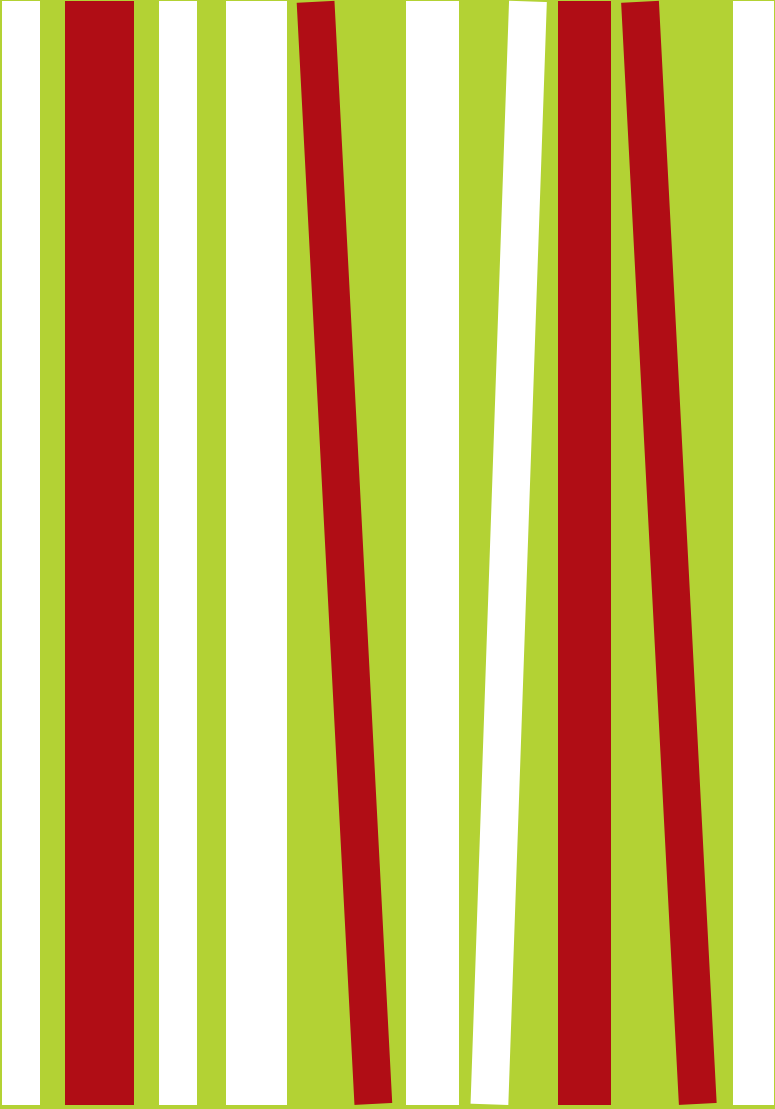


## The Treaty of San Francisco

The Treaty of San Francisco signed in 1951 has been considered as a possible cause for the Cold War regime in East Asia and territorial disputes in the region. That is because Japan, though reaping the benefit of recovering full sovereignty in return for paying the war reparations, has ironically used the treaty as an exemption from its past responsibilities for colonial rule and wartime atrocities. This book, as a collection of research results on the seventy-year history and issues of the Treaty of San Francisco, seeks for the ways for resolving the territorial disputes and for building an East Asian peace community on the base of the Japanese duties to respect the United Nations Charter and to perform the Universal Declaration of Human Rights, as enunciated in the Treaty's beginning.

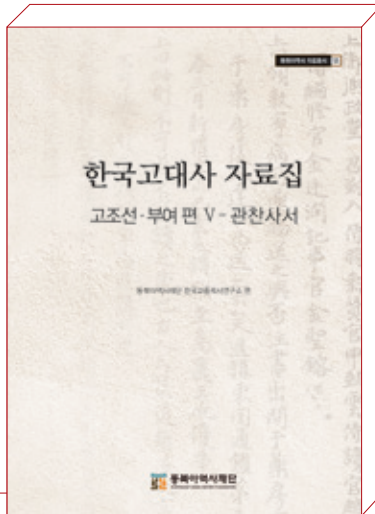

This sourcebook, the fourth volume in the series of Edited Translation of *Sadaemungwe*, is an annotated translation of the *Sadaemungwe* (*gweon* 17). It consists of 50 diplomatic documents exchanged between Joseon and the Ming from the 5th month to the 10th month of 1596 before and after the failure of peace negotiations between the Ming and Japan. This volume provides the historical materials illustrating how Joseon and the Ming maintained cooperative relations amid their concerns for domestic and regional security. In particular, this volume offers a chance to grasp the realities of military cooperation and special relations between Joseon and the Ming during the period of the Imjin War.

The sourcebook contains both official and personal records on Jang Han-sang, such as the "Funeral Records of Gyodong Admiral," the Funeral Orations for Gyodong Admiral," the "Real Records of Two Generals," and the Epitaphs of Two Generals."

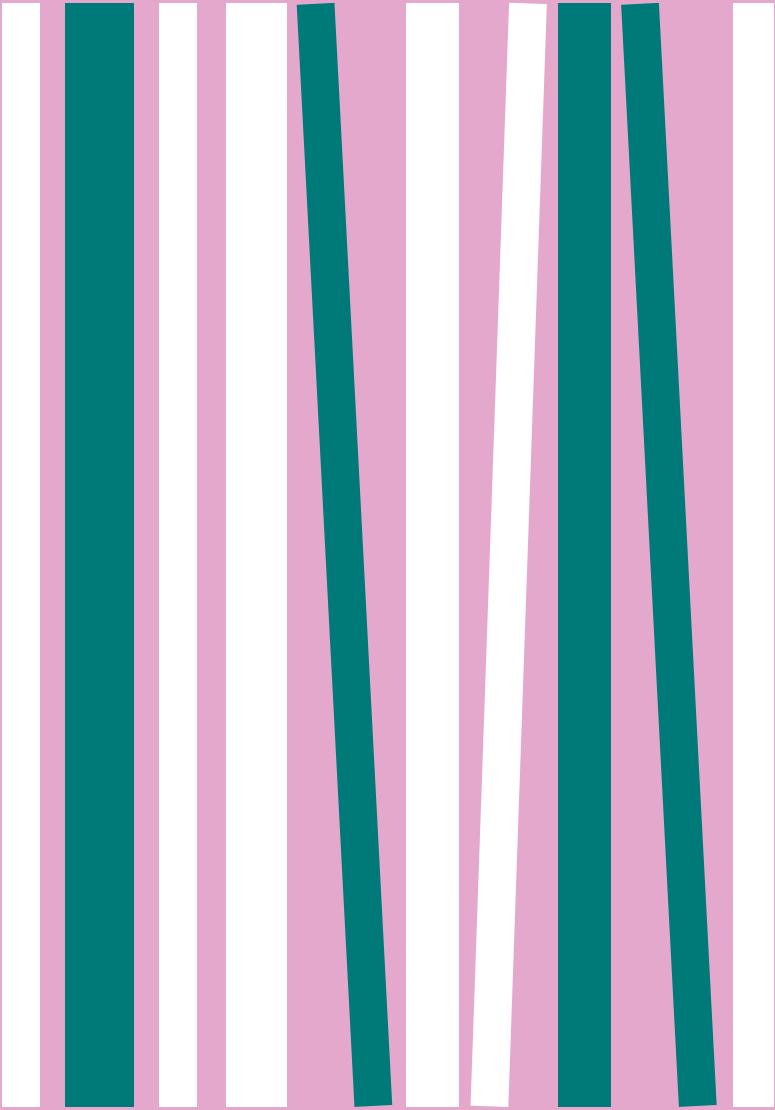


## First Encounters between Westerners and Koreans in Beijing

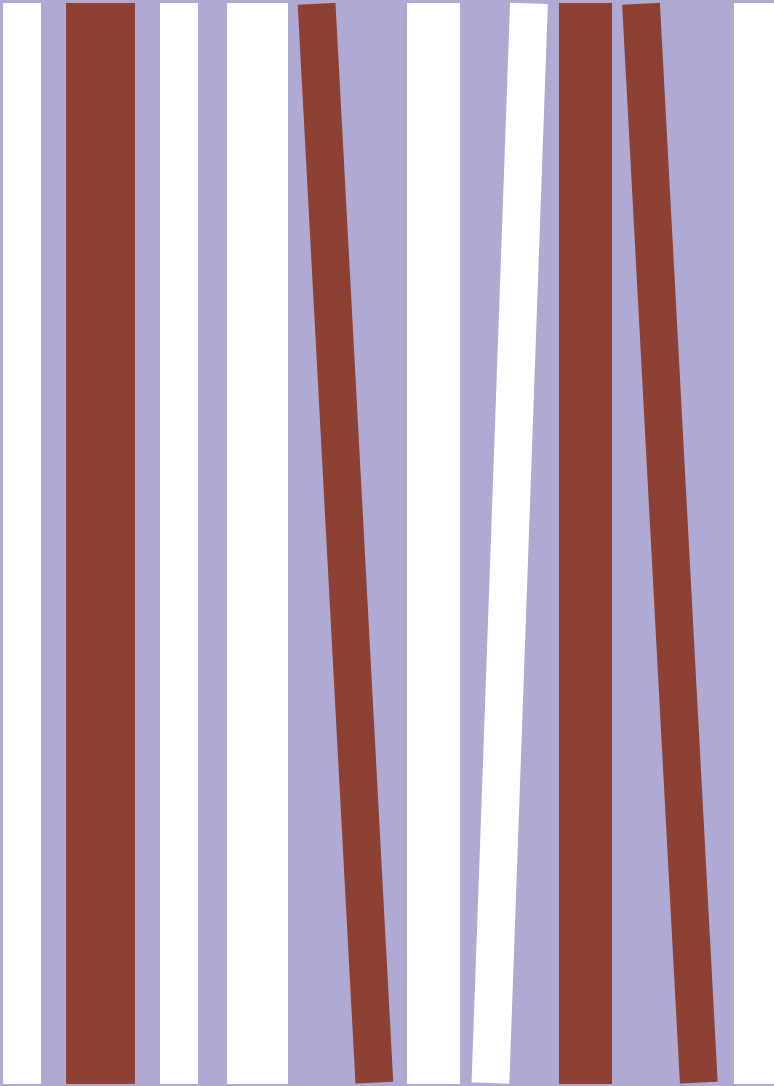

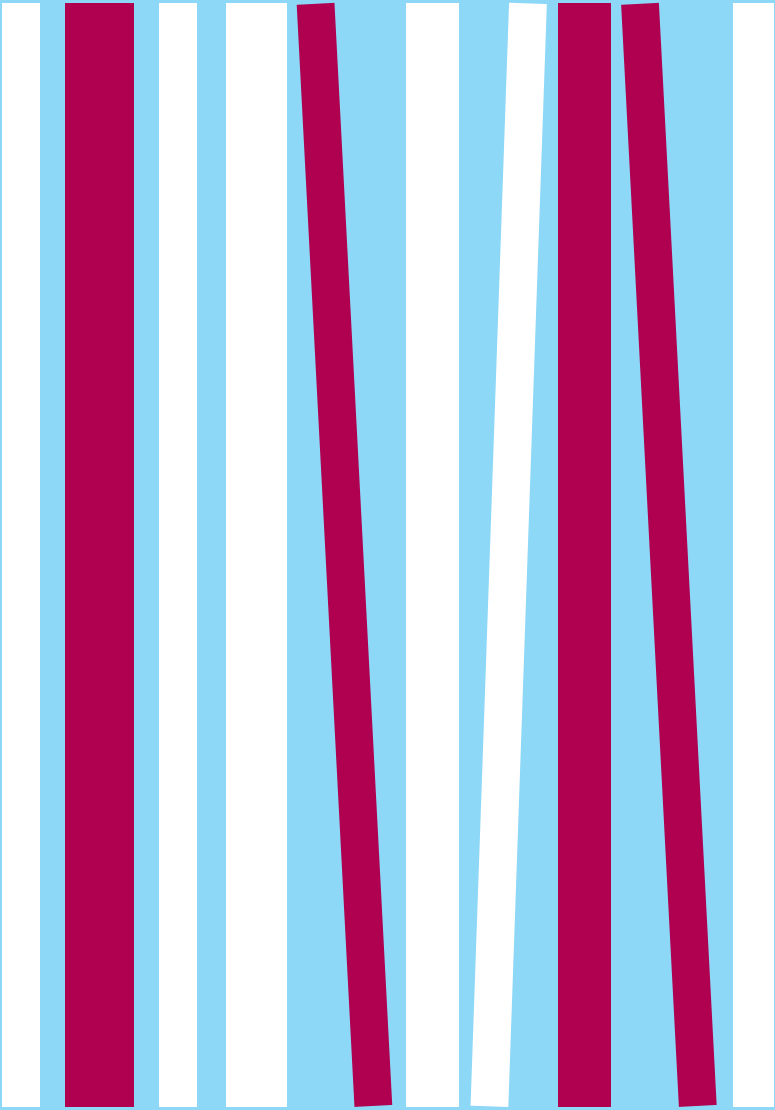

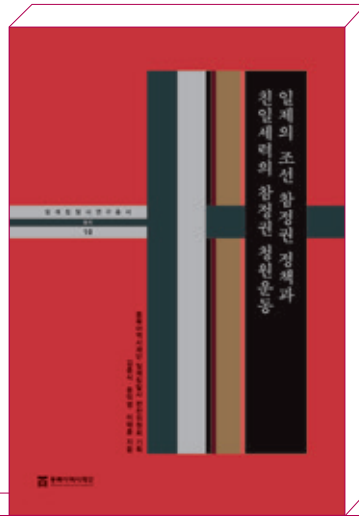
This book presents an outline history of the imperialist policies of the Japanese governors of Korea. The book puts the subject of the imperialist rule of the Japanese governors of Korea within the global context of total war mobilization ushered in during the First and Second World War. Adopting of such broader global perspective on the Japanese colonial domination over Korea allows us to have a clear idea of far more oppressive and exploitative nature of the Japanese colonial rule than those of Western imperial powers.



## Japan's Turning Korea into Protectorate and Colony

The international contest for colonies among the imperial powers reached its peak during the period from the Russo-Japanese War to the annexation of Korea by Japan. It is important to see Japan's turning Korea into protectorate (1905) and formal colony (1910) within the international context of "high imperialism." Therefore, Japan took an attentive approach to the Western powers' responses at the time of the Russo-Japanese War and the subsequent Portsmouth Treaty (1905), and succeeded in eliciting their agreement on the annexation of Korea as a formal colony.



## Imperial Japan's Policies toward Korean Political Participation, and Pro-Japanese Koreans' Petition Movement for Political Participation

In particular, the book illustrates the subjects related to pro-Japanese Korean forces, such as their formation as a political force, and their ideas and movements for political autonomy and participation as well as significance and structural limits of such movements.



## History of Suppressing Korean Nationalist and Socialist Movements during the Japan's Forced Occupation of Korea

In addition, the book also describes the personal data and career activities of prominent police officers, prosecutors, and judges affiliated with the Government General of Korea (GGK), who were in charge of handling the thought control cases.

Over the past decade, research on Koguryo history has seen the most substantial change among historical research into ancient Korean kingdoms. New directions and methodologies have been explored using the early articles in the Koguryo Annals of Samguk sagi, or the History of the Three Kingdoms. Research topics have grown more specific and diverse, especially in studying the history of Koguryo's politics and external relations. Archaeological studies have gone beyond attempts to offer general observations on North Korean research findings and have been introducing archaeological sources in China. Increased investigations into Koguryo remains in areas south of the Imjin River have led to the production of original research findings. The purpose of A History of Koguryo is to faithfully present to academia and the general public the research findings on Koguryo history. The book is therefore expected to serve as a guide to incipient scholars, and for history enthusiasts, as a resource to help them encounter new aspects of Koguryo.

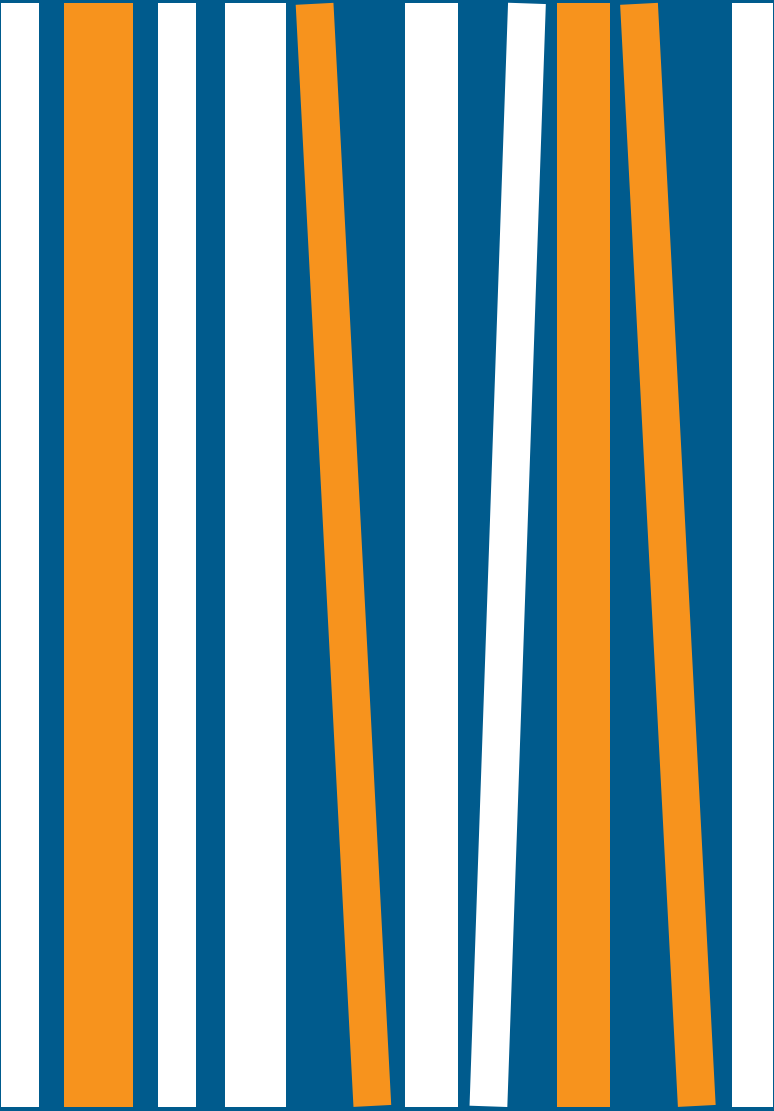

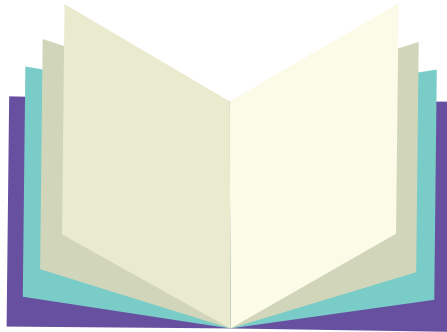

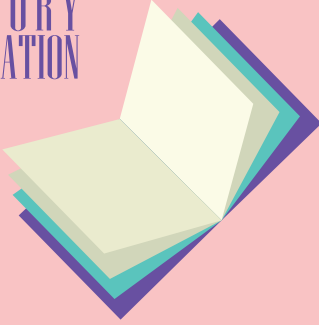
